We are excited to announce a change that will be taking place on the Avondale Meadows campus at the start of the 2022-2023 school year. Avondale Meadows Academy will serve Kindergarten through 4th grade and Avondale Meadows Middle School will serve 5th-8th grade scholars.

We are confident that this shift will have a positive impact on future 5th graders. The Indiana state standards have become more complex in recent years and content based instruction, including rigorous science and social studies courses, will better prepare students for middle and high school.

Avondale Meadows Middle School (AMMS) will serve the fifth and sixth graders in an intermediate model that is developmentally appropriate and will allow for better preparation for 7th and 8th grade and beyond.

We are confident that the leaders and staff at both schools will collaborate effectively to ensure a smooth transition for all. The teams are already busy planning for a variety of activities to support the onboarding of current 4th graders to AMMS. As most of you know, the buildings are connected and co-located on the same campus so the physical change for students and families is minimal. Students will move to a new section of the campus and the arrival and dismissal process for families is very similar.
